On February 26, 2010 Arboga Elementary School was awarded the 'Design to Earn ENERGY STAR' by the Environmental Protection Agency (EPA).



By designing projects that receive a rating of 75 or higher with ENERGY STAR'S Target Finder, projects are eligible to earn the prestigious "Designed to Earn ENERGY STAR" award. To qualify, eligible designs must be 95% complete with construction documents and the building cannot be occupied or generating utility bills. Buildings that earn the ENERGY STAR label typically use 35% less energy than average buildings.
